Tracking and Analytics

A trusted third party analytics provider may also be used to track the URL of the page you just came from (whether from this website or another), the URL of the page you visit next (whether on this website or another), information about the device you are using and your internet providers (IP) address. This data is usually collected automatically by any website you visit in order to help improve the services and experiences they provide.

The Use of Cookies

7. This website uses cookies to assist us in the process of collecting certain data. Cookies are small pieces of computer code which enable web servers to identify users. They do not store any information you voluntarily provide us with through this website.
8. Cookie files can be deleted manually from your devices hard drive at any time or can be avoided by configuring your web browser to notify you before a cookie is placed on your hard drive or by rejecting them altogether.

Payments

We do not collect any data or information regarding payments, including (but not limited to), credit/debit card details, account numbers or sort codes which are made to this website via any third party payment system and recommend that you read and understand the terms and conditions and privacy policy relating to any such payment system.
